BUDGET COMMITTEE

Members will be asked to review the proposed draft budget prior to the meeting and make any comments or propose amendments during the meeting, then vote on a recommendation to City Council after discussion. Mayor's Message

Spring means annual budget time in Rivergrove and the other cities in Oregon. Our Budget Committee, composed of citizens, including City Councilors, will meet on April 14, 2014 to discuss the draft budget prepared by our City Manager/Recorder, Sheri Richards. No rubber stamping here—our Committee asks tough questions as it looks into the sources of Rivergrove's income, as well as the current year's expenditures and proposed income/expenditures for the coming fiscal year. When the draft meets with their approval, the budget heads to City Council for public comments and adoption.

Former Budget Committee members will be invited back this year, but new members are indeed welcome! If you're curious about the City's finances and would like to be involved, please send to sheri@cityofrivergrove.com.

If you live near the Tualatin River, or in the 100-year Flood Plain, please contact the City before building a fence, shed, dock or other structure, or adding topsoil, rocks or re-landscaping. These activities are considered "development" and they require a development permit from the City. That may sound unnecessarily draconian, but this is required of the City in order to participate in FEMA's flood insurance program—a right Rivergrove would lose if this law is not enforced. If you have already built or added any of these, please let us know and we can work with you to obtain a permit now, to bring your property into compliance.

Use Caution at Pilkington & Childs! The shoulder on the east side of Pilkington just north of Childs has been washed out by heavy rains. The City is working with Clackamas County on this, but until the shoulder has been restored, please use extreme caution when turning north onto Pilkington from Childs Road.
