### **BUDGET HEARING AND PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING STATE SHARED REVENUE**

## Mayor's Message

For the first time in 15 years, Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue, which serves 440,000 citizens in west-side communities such as Rivergrove, will be asking us all to vote for renewal of their Local Option tax levy, with a 20-cent per \$1000 increase in funding, at the May 2014 election.

Recently, Chief Mike Duyck outlined the reasons for the increase in a presentation to City Council. The region's growing population has led to an increase in response time, somewhat higher than the optimal 5 minutes and 12 seconds. To shorten response time, TVFR uses a variety of smaller vehicles for some non-fire calls and, in fact, medical situations are by far the most common emergency call. To meet this need, TVFR now trains fire fighter/medics to accompany its response teams.

The replacement levy will allow TVF&R to maintain their existing corps of 42 trained medics and to add another 44 medics. The levy will also provide additional apparatus and enable the development of two more emergency response stations.
