## Mayor's Message

Heritage Park was the recent recipient of many native plants. My planting pal, Jeri Parrish and I filled the cypress log bed Arne Nyberg had created with a variety of natives, including vine maple, Willamette Valley ponderosa pine, Nootka rose, swamp rose, mock orange, kinnikinnick, tufted hairgrass, Oregon iris, and Oregon grape, among others. In the wetlands, we added stream violets, willow and red osier dogwood. Still to come are other trees and shrubs, such as native red currant, Indian plum, Pacific crabapple and more Oregon white oak. The cypress logs are expressly for climbing and sitting. Thank you, Jeri, for your afternoon of hard work!

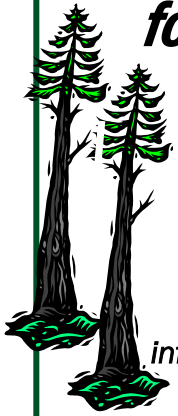
The City is seeking donations to help bring a water line from the road to Heritage Park, and later to fund a drinking fountain there. A bench --a generous gift in memory of Lauri Rathmann--will be installed shortly near the century-old pear trees (a remnant of the old Pilkington Nursery that occupied so much of the land that is present-day Rivergrove).

Although we are not able to mow Heritage Park again until mid-July, to protect wildlife breeding grounds, a path will be mowed this week around the park to create a pleasant place to stroll. Enjoy your park!
