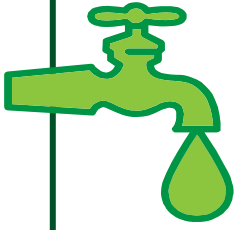

Every even-numbered year, 3 or more candidates run for 3 seats on City Council. This year, the candidates are Councilor Mary Mann and I—both of us are seeking re-election—and Carolyn Bahrman, running for the seat soon to be vacated by David Dull, whose term expires at the end of the year. The two candidates receiving the highest votes will have 4-year terms, and the third candidate, a 2-year term. And yes—we'd like your votes! We'll be bringing you an invitation to a "Meet the Candidates Night" and we're ready to hear what you'd like us to accomplish in the next year.

A final word of thanks to all the wonderful Rivergrove citizens who help care for our parks, by watering during heat waves, and digging blackberry vines and weeds.
