Mayor's Message

A call from a Rivergrove resident prompted me to clarify with our emergency services providers exactly who responds to an urgent 911 call from Rivergrove. The answer is reassuring: in an emergency situation, the closest available provider will respond, no matter where that response team is located. For example, if the Lake Oswego or Tualatin police can respond more promptly than the sheriff of either county, they will be the first on the scene. However the sheriff's department will respond as well and will ultimately take the responsibility for further investigation.

Through intergovernmental agreements, our City relies on the Clackamas County and Washington County Sheriff's departments for law enforcement, and we have an agreement with Tualatin Valley Fire & Rescue for fire and medical emergency services. However, when a 911 call is placed, all of this area's providers receive notice. So even for non-emergency situations, such as a burglary discovered after the fact, it isn't necessary to call more than one department. For such non-urgent situations, report this to the non-emergency number for the sheriff in your county and you can be assured that the various local law enforcement agencies will receive word as well.

There are 25 cities in Metro, so emergency response could be a headache without a state law specifically allowing law enforcement and emergency teams to provide service in another jurisdiction. We often see the Lake Oswego police stopping speeders along Childs Road, and this same ordinance gives them the right to do so.

An important note: **If at all possible, place a 911 call from your landline**, rather than a cell phone, to avoid any possible routing confusion.
