How fortunate that Rivergrove citizens have always been willing to participate in efforts to improve the quality of life in our city! Right now, your participation is needed on one of two committees:

1. Transformation of Childs Road & Pilkington: Help draft a plan to create improved "collector" roads in Rivergrove, with an eye to safety, slower traffic, neighborhood identification and connectivity. If you or your children walk these pedways and crosswalks, drive along these roads (don't we all!), and are concerned about what will happen to our roads as the region's population increases, please offer to serve on this short-term committee, which hopes to have answers to present by mid-spring. Clackamas County which has jurisdiction of these roads, has agreed to follow Rivergrove's plan to shape these collectors, so the creation of a plan is essential.

2. Rivergrove's Tree Committee: Rivergrove is now the state's smallest and newest *Tree City USA* member, so volunteers are needed to find ways to celebrate Arbor Day (on April 30th this year) and to develop tree education programs in Rivergrove. Needed are people with ideas—who love to plan events! In fact, Rivergrove's 45th birthday is in March, so let's combine the two celebrations and have fun!
