In spring, in Rivergrove, with Arbor Day around the corner, it's hard to think of anything but trees. This year, Rivergrove celebrates its second year as a Tree City USA community, with a month of activities not only to increase tree canopy, but also to turn the city's focus on the preservation and enhancement of our natural heritage.

With this edition of the Rivergrove Report, you'll find a special flier listing the city's Arbor Month events scheduled throughout April. Starting with our official Arbor Day celebration on April 1st, which includes a planting session for adults and children, to add trees to the young oak savanna in Heritage Park, and native pussy willow cuttings to root around the wetland—there are events for the entire family. At our April 1st Planting Day, come dig and plant or bring a chair, supervise and visit with neighbors. The City will receive its second year TCUSA award from the Arbor Day Foundation, presented by our City Arborist, Brian French. Of course, we'll have tree cookies and beverages, and everyone will get to take home a seedling—there'll be some to fit any size yard.

For those who wonder why our celebration isn't on the last Friday in April, designated as National Arbor Day, there's a simple reason: trees grow better here when planted earlier. Be sure to check out the flier for more activities.
